Houston, Texas, March 1, 2016 - On February 24, 2015 RadioShack filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy protection. The giant electronics retailer began as the Tandy Leather Factory in Fort Worth in 1919 and grew to over 3,600 locations. Under its bankruptcy plan the company shuttered almost 1,800 stores. About 1,800 more locations were sold to Standard General/General Wireless who partnered with Sprint. Many of the locations remain open under new ownership.

Following the filing of the bankruptcy, Perdue, Brandon, Fielder, Collins & Mott LLP immediately began the substantial task of gathering tax claim information statewide for all the taxing entities it represents. The Firm, through its locations throughout the state, coordinated and guided the filing of numerous bankruptcy claims on behalf of its clients. The firm carefully monitored the case through a contentious confirmation process and participated in the confirmation hearing for over two full days. A plan of liquidation requiring the payment of taxes was signed on October 2, 2015. Following confirmation of the plan, the 2014 taxes remaining delinquent were paid, leaving only the 2015 taxes, which were not yet delinquent, to be resolved.

After a delay of several months, on the eve of delinquency in late January 2016, representatives of the Liquidating Trustee responded to inquiries from the firm regarding payment of the 2015 taxes. Due to the efforts of Perdue Brandon, on January 29, 2016, the final tax payments of \$206,850.80 were made to those taxing entities represented by the Firm. This money can be used in our schools and for other governmental services.
